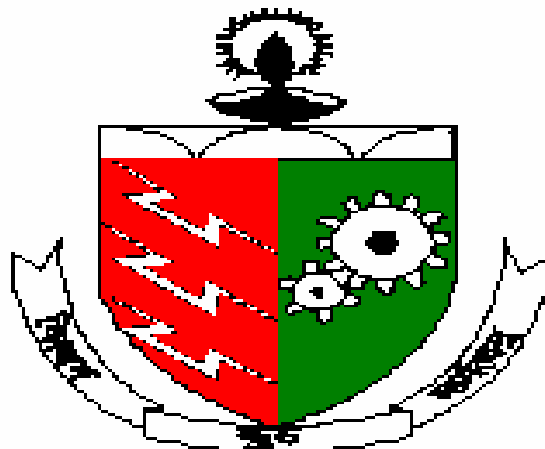

(i) **Teaching methodology:**

Strength: Class room teaching (OHP, LCD Projector), Group discussion followed by Tutorials and laboratory classes are the strength for all round development of the students (conceptual, practical, management and leadership skill).

Provision for expert lecture has been introduced. Expert lectures are being delivered by subject Experts from ISM, Dhanbad, BIT, Mesra, IIT, Kharagpur, IT BHU and people from Industry.

(ii) **Innovation:**

(a) Students read books of their choice in the library making optimum use of the library. Seminars and Symposia are organized by the students regularly to improve their innovation skills.

(b) Faculty members act as interviewer for the students. The process helps the students in their placement.

(iii) **Introduction of Semester system**

Introduction of Semester system from the admission year 2006-07 with the approval of the University. A copy of the structure of the courses for various disciplines approved by the Academic Council and the syndicate of the University will be sent separately.


