#### **BOG/AGEN/6/2019/06/02**

#### **Actions to be reported**

2.01 Total 21 Nos. of Research Projects have been allotted to the faculties of BIT Sindri under collaborative research Scheme (CRS) of MHRD under TEQIP-III. (13 in Phase-I, 06 in Phase-II and 02 in Phase-III). Total Budget allotted is 184.85 Lacs.

*(Annex-II)*

*Resolution: BOG was happy to note the achievements of BIT Sindri. BOG Members congratulated the project earners and hope that others who could not earn the projects will strive to earn the research funding in the near future.*

2.02 One of the students idea/ project has been selected in HACKATHON arranged by Govt. of Jharkhand.

*Resolution: Success of the student in the HACKATHON was noted by the BOG members with satisfaction. Entire committee congratulated the Director.*

2.03 Incubation Centre of BIT SINDRI has already been setup with the provision for 40 incubates and the centre has been linked with Jharkhand Innovation lab.

**Resolution:** This incubation centre (I.C.) was highly needed by BIT Sindri and commissioning of this I.C. to cater 40 incubates at a time is highly commendable. This centre is also linked with Jharkhand innovation lab (JIL) therefore BOG Members feel pleasure to congratulate Professor In-charge Incubation Centre, Prof. Prakash Kumar, HOD Production Engineering Department.

2.04 Regulation of Ph.D. program under JUT, Ranchi has been drafted through BOS meeting on 22<sup>nd</sup> of June 2019 under the Chairmanship of VC JUT, Prof. G Pathak.

**Resolution:** BIT Sindri should now start the PhD program at the earliest. It will help to improve the NIRF ranking and effort should be made to bring BIT Sindri within 100 of NIRF ranking.

2.05 Curriculum of 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> semesters B. Tech. for all Branches have been revised through BOS on 24<sup>th</sup> June 2019 under the Chairmanship of former VC, VBU Hazaribag, Prof. Gurdeep Singh. MOOCs have been introduced for the first time.

**Resolution:** Curriculum revision is essential and it should be done regularly to improve the curriculum content as often as possible to engulf the latest developments in the disciplines.

2.06 For the first time a course of 02 credits on Entrepreneurship has been introduced for students of 6<sup>th</sup> semester in all branches of undergraduate course (B. Tech. Program) to promote Startup and Entrepreneurship.

**Resolution:** Entrepreneurship and character buildings are required for all Engineering students to develop himself/herself as an engineer in totality. Therefore BOG appreciates this effort of BIT Sindri in developing the skill of Entrepreneurship among the students. Introduction of MOOCS was well appreciated.

2.07 One of the M. Tech. students from control system specialization, Mr Gaurav Prasad, has been selected for paid internship in Tata Steel.

**Resolution:** BOG appreciated this effort and emphasizes that more number of students should be brought in and encouraged achieving this type of feat.

during the time of training.


