## GENERAL RULES

- The Competition is open to all.
- The Competition is absolutely free for everyone and no registration charges or fees will be taken for any Event or Workshop.
- Although CAD basics will be taught in the webinar, all the participants are advised to have basic knowledge & understanding of any CAD software in advance.
- The participants can use any CAD software to design their model although it is preferred to use AutoCAD Fusion 360.
- The designs are to be submitted in ".step" format, along with top, bottom, side and isometric view of the design in "jpeg" or "png" format.
- The winners of the AAKRITI will be decided keeping following parameters into consideration
  - I) Relevance to the given problem statement.
  - II) Practical Applicability of the model.
  - III) Innovation in the design or application of the model.
  - IV) Uniqueness of the model.
  - V) Presentability of the model.
- Any sort of cheating and misleading act detected or suspected will be taken into action immediately and will lead to disqualification of the participants.
- Participants will be given fixed time and are required to submit their designs within that stipulated time.
- It is advisable for all participants to attend the 7 days workshop successfully. Those who will attend the Workshop will gain perks which will help them compete.
- The decision of the organizing committee will be considered final in case of any discordance.
- Rules and regulations of the events are subject to change at the discretion of the organizing committee. However, the participants will receive prior notifications if any such changes were to take place. It is strongly advised that the participants only refer to the latest rule book..
