WHEREAS:

- A. HPPL is having its manufacturing plant at Sarigam, Valsad District of Gujarat. HPPL is into of manufacturing, marketing & sale of industrial oils and chemicals, lubricants, greases, hydraulic fluids and processing compounds and chemicals for the metal working including heat treatment and quenchants, cutting coolants, rust preservatives, cleaners, corrosive preparations, drawing compounds, rolling oils and fire resistant hydraulic fluids, etc. and undertakes R&D in lubricants and additives under categories of Plant Performance Improvement (PPI). Product Development (PD), Scientific Investigation and Development (SID), Basic Research and Technical Services (TS). HPPL has research team comprising of highly qualified and dedicated researchers and engineers and is equipped with modern research equipment at its laboratory in Sarigam, Valsad District of Gujarat.
- B. BIT is an institution managing one of the older and most reputed college of India. College is administratively under the Department of Higher, Technical Education & Skill Development, Govt. of Jharkhand, Ranchi and academically it is affiliated to Vinoba Bhave University, Hazaribag for conducting examinations and awarding degrees. All courses are approved by All India Council of Technical Education. The main aim of the institute is to cater to the needs of the nation for manpower development. The college offers B. NOW THE **PARTIES** THIS UNDERSTANDING AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Term of the MoU

This MoU shall be for a period of 5 years effective from 28th January 2022 and unless terminated earlier by either of the Parties shall expire on 27th January 2027.

2. Objectives of Parties

BIT and HPPL as a part of their understanding and obligations under this MoU agree as under:

- BIT and HPPL will jointly work on science and technology related a) awareness programs in the field of lubricants and allied products.
- HPPL shall conduct technical workshops/training program to educate students of BIT on products and processes.
- HPPL shall impart need based skill training to selected students of c) BIT in the areas of HPPL's operation.
- HPPL shall provide opportunities on merit basis to the students of d) BIT for placement, summer training and paid internship.
- Further, a Joint Coordination Committee of the Parties will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the Parties.

- a) To accomplish the objective mentioned above, it is envisage shall hold discussions to finalise terms for undertaking specific proposals line projects. During discussions, all matters of mutual interest formulated and documented for future references and applications course of the activities under separate agreement. Issues intellectual property rights shall be mentioned in the agreement while finalising the research projects. This MoU does not deal in any understanding towards Parties carrying any research activities.
- b) Further, it is also agreed to hold such discussions and consultation on periodic basis as and when desired...
- c) The expenses towards travel, boarding and lodging for the visits envisaged for preparing and finalising the joint projects of mutual interest shall be borne by the respective Parties. However, it is agreed to provide local travelling facilities to the visiting faculty/experts by the host Party wherever possible.
- d) Vacancies for summer training, internships shall be informed in writing by HPPL to BIT and BIT shall bring such vacancies to the knowledge of its students by putting such communication on notice board, portal of BIT or in any other appropriate manner. HPPL shall have sole right to decide the term of internship, letter of undertaking from student, the stipend of the interns and other rules regulating such internships.

4. Methodology:

- a) HPPL shall provide some study material to BIT which may be used by BIT as a part of its curriculum.
- b) Experts of HPPL may visit the premises of BIT to give guest lectures to the students of BIT.
- c) HPPL may select students of BIT and impart them practical exposure of industry where it operates in the form of internships.

6. Intellectual Property

The Parties herein shall not claim rights over intellectual properties of the other Party. The Parties undertake not deal in intellectual properties of other Party. This MoU does not deal in creation of any intellectual property /intellectual rights for any Party.

7. Confidentiality

The Parties agree that there is no intention to share any confidential or proprietary information in any collaboration under this MoU. If either Party wishes to disclose information pertaining to the other Party it considers to be confidential or proprietary, the Parties will enter into a separate non-disclosure agreement.

8. Notice

During the tenure of this MoU, either Party can terminate this MoU for breach of any of the terms of this MoU or otherwise, giving three (3) months' notice in writing to the other Party. In the event of termination of this MoU, the rights and obligations of the Parties hereto shall be settled by mutual discussion. This MoU may also be terminated by mutual agreement amongst the Parties if it becomes apparent that the proposed concept is not feasible. Each Party represents, warrants and covenants with the other Party that the Parties and their affiliates, owners, officers, employees, agents, subcontractors, consultants, and representatives (collectively referred to as "Representatives") will perform all of their obligations under this MoU in compliance with all local, state, national, and international statutes, rulings, regulations, ordinances, and governmental directives, including, without limitation, those pertaining to regulation of trade, the environment, transportation, safety, health, and employment

There shall be no arbitration towards resolution of disputes under this MoU. All disputes under this MoU which cannot be resolved mutually and amicably by Parties, if referred to court shall be subject to exclusive jurisdiction of courts at Mumbai, Maharashtra.

12. Severability

If any of the terms and conditions or provisions of this MoU is held or found to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable, such term, condition or provision shall be severed and the remaining terms, conditions and provisions shall remain binding and effective.

13. Entire Understanding

This MoU represents the entire understanding between the Parties and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations or understanding, either oral or written, between the Parties. This MoU may be amended only by a written instrument signed by the respective authorized persons of both Parties.
