On behalf of BIT Sindri, a premier technical Institute in Jharkhand, I am honored to offer you the position of Adjunct Professor in the department of Mechanical Engineering for two years under the following terms & conditions:


3. Your appointment as an "Adjunct Professor" is for an initial period of two years, which will be extended as per the requirement of the Institute.
4. A) You will visit BIT Sindri once a year for a minimum period of one week to three weeks. You are required to teach (online/offline mode) our undergraduate and graduate students at least one full course of 40 hours each, during your visit. (For foreign faculty members).
B) Faculty members of the inside state (Jharkhand) are required to stay in the campus for a minimum of one week per month and will have to take at least one week of class at one stretch. They will be given TA/DA only once per month. Other conditions will remain the same like foreign faculty members.
3. You will guide our students and faculty members to explore the area of mutual interest to do joint research, consultancy etc with our faculty members and students. You may supervise / co-supervise our Ph.D. scholars, M. Tech. students and B. Tech Students.
- 7 You may publish research papers as a co-author with our students, and faculty members in national and/or internationally recognized journals/conference/seminars on the topic of mutual interest.
- 8 You will guide BIT Sindri in organizing international conference/seminars on the topic of mutual interest.
- 9 Please note that your appointment is without any financial implications. You will be paid an honorarium for the hours your teach at BIT Sindri to our students as per BIT Sindri rules/guidelines. You will be paid an honorarium of Indian Rs.1,20,000 for 40 hours of teaching (equivalent to one course or two half courses) maximum in one semester. In case, your are teaching for 20 hours or less in a course/lecture, you will be paid an honorarium of Rs.3000/- per hour.

Your Honorarium, TA & DA etc will be paid through endowment fund sponsored by BITSANA.

7. BIT Sindri will make the necessary arrangements for travel (single return air ticket in economy class for travel in India). The Institute will also provide the local transportation up to the nearest airport /railway station.
8. BIT Sindri will make arrangements for your lodging and boarding in its Guest House facility free of cost for the duration as outlined in Item 2 above.
9. If you wish to bring your spouse with you to BIT Sindri, you will be responsible for your spouse's all travels by air/train to BIT Sindri. However, BIT Sindri will provide for the boarding and lodging of the spouse.


