BIT Sindri Marks Jharkhand's Silver Jubilee with a Week of Cultural and Creative Celebrations.

On the 25th anniversary of Jharkhand's formation, BIT Sindri came alive with vibrant celebrations filled with creativity and joy. A variety of programmes and competitions were organised including Quiz, Debate, Live Painting, Pot Painting, Face Painting and Essay Writing Competitions, each reflecting the rich culture of Jharkhand in a warm and spirited way. These events gave students an open and cheerful space to express their talents and with art, music and enthusiastic participation all around, the campus glowed with the pride of the state and the youthful energy of its students.



LIVE PAINTING COMPETITION

The celebrations commenced on 11 November with a 'Live Painting' competition organised by the BIT Sindri (Painting Wing). Students from various departments participated enthusiastically and showcased their artistic talent. Their artwork depicted shades of emotion from the essence of Jharkhand's tribal culture to contemporary perspectives. The celebration not only paid tribute to the state's unique identity but also served as a platform for students to express their ideas, talents and aspirations for Jharkhand's future. In this event, Nishi Kujur (Production) secured the first prize, followed by Payal Murmu (Chemical) in second place, while Ram Kumar Pandit (Mechanical) earned the third position.



ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION

On the second day, 12 November, Sarjana and the Literary Society of BIT Sindri jointly organised an essay writing competition titled 'QuillQuest'. The theme for the competition was "My Vision for Jharkhand @50". Students of the institute actively participated and demonstrated impressive writing abilities. A total of 75 students actively participated in the competition organized as part of the scheduled events. The event was conducted under the guidance of Dr. Rajeev Kumar Verma (Dean Student Welfare), Prof. Maya Raj Narayan Rai, Prof. Rekha Jha and Prof. Priyanka. The President of the Literary Society, the Editor-in-Chief of Sarjana and other members were also present during the event. In the essay writing competition, Mili Kumari (ECE), Sujal Saw (Mining Engineering) and Muskan Agrawal (Chemical Engineering) secured the first, second and third positions, respectively.



QUIZ COMPETITION

On the same day, NSS BIT Sindri organised a quiz competition on Jharkhand's history, social and cultural heritage, witnessing the enthusiastic participation of 80 students who showcased both their knowledge and quick-thinking abilities. The final round of the quiz was conducted on 14 November.

Team Alpha secured the first position, followed by Team BIT Brains in second place and Team Think Twice in third place.



PAINT-A-POT COMPETITION

On 12th November, as part of the celebration, the Painting Wing hosted a vibrant Paint-a-Pot competition at the Deshpandey Auditorium, where students transformed plain terracotta pots into stunning works of art using themes inspired by nature, wildlife, and cultural patterns. Together, these designs not only showcased the students' creativity but also expressed a deeper tribute to Jharkhand's ecological richness and cultural identity, making each pot a meaningful artistic narrative rather than just a decorative piece. The Pot Painting Competition highlighted students' creativity and craftsmanship, with participants presenting beautifully designed and intricately decorated pots. Kirti Kumari (IT) claimed the first prize, while Yamini Murmu (CSE) secured the second position and Ankita Raj (IT) stood third in the event.



FACE PAINTING COMPETITION

The following day, on 13 November, the Face Painting Competition drew enthusiastic participation, featuring innovative themes and vibrant artistic expressions which added colour and festive energy to the campus. In this competition, Sakshi Shreya (Civil) achieved the first prize, Mili Kumari (ECE) secured the second position, and Shivam Singh (Mechanical) attained the third place.



DEBATE COMPETITION

NSS conducted the first round of the debate competition on 13 November, followed by the final round on 14 November, bringing an intellectually engaging and competitive close to the series of NSS-organised events. The competition was structured with participants divided into two groups, one representing the “For” side and the other representing the “Against” side. On the “For” side, Rahul, Mili Kumari (ECE) and Nandan Kumar (Mechanical) secured the first, second, and third positions, respectively. The “Against” side comprised Himanshu (ECE), Abhishek Kumar (Metallurgy) and Minu Kumari (Chemical), who achieved the first, second, and third positions, respectively.
