This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU) is made on this ^{31st} day of the month of ^{JANUARY} in the year 2026 by and between the BIT, Sindri (Jharkhand) [hereinafter called "BIT" First Party] having its Head Office at Dhanbad Road, PO Sindri Institute, Sindri- 828123 .(Jharkhand) and Binod Bihari Mahto Koyalanchal University with its headquarter at P.O Nagnagar ,P.S Barwadda, Dhanbad- 826004 (Jharkhand) and Bihar Institute of Technology [hereinafter called "BBMKU" Second Party] on the OTHER PART Hereinafter, collectively referred to as the parties.

The parties, having discussed fields of common academic and research interests, have decided to enter into collaboration initially for five years for promotion of undergraduate/post-graduate/ PhD programs in cutting-edge areas by facilitating students to seek specialized guidance and facilities at BIT, Sindri and *vice-versa*.

WHEREAS, BIT Sindri ("First Party") is previously known as Bihar Institute of Technology, Sindri, was a subsidiary of Ranchi College. Later, it became the affiliated engineering college of Vinoba Bhave University, Hazaribag. Currently, it is under the affiliation of the Jharkhand University of Technology, Ranchi. Hence, the degree is honoured by the JUT . The primary aim of the Institute is to cater to the requirements of the country for technological manpower for development and research programs comparable to the best in the world. The college today offers B.Tech. courses in 10 disciplines of engineering, namely Mechanical, Electrical, Metallurgy, Production, Chemical, Electronics and Communications, Civil, Mining, Computer Science, and Information Technology. On 5th September 2017, B.I.T. Sindri was declared as the first and foremost centre of excellence by the Department of Higher, Technical Education & Skill Development, Government of Jharkhand with the Chief Minister Shri Raghubar Das inaugurating the 14 new hi-tech laboratories which were established on campus is



assistance with CISCO, Oracle, Siemens India and Ericsson for developing further engineering skills of the students.

AND WHEREAS the "Second Party" The Binod Bihari Mahto Koyalanchal University(BBMKU) is a State University, established by THE JHARKHAND STATE UNIVERSITIES (AMENDMENT) Act, 2017 notified on 23rd March, 2017 and published vide Gazette notification no. 216 (Extra Ordinary) dated 11th April, 2017, bears the name of the legendary local figure Binod Bihari Mahto jee. The University comprises of twenty eight postgraduate departments, 13 constituent colleges, 23 affiliated colleges, 01 Deficit Grant Minority College, 23 B.Ed. colleges, 03 law colleges, 01 medical college, 02 nursing colleges and 01 Pharmacy College. BBMKU is a premier Academic Institute providing Under Graduate, Post Graduate and Ph.D. Program in various fields including Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science, Geology, Environmental Science and Disaster Management, Management, Microbiology ,Life Science, Molecular Biology, Sociology, Psychology and other allied subjects and having highly qualified academicians engaged in teaching and research activities. AND WHEREAS, It has been considered expedient to agree in writing to participate jointly in the academic, research and training activities requiring expertise from both the parties as when required by mutual consent.

Article 1. Scope

1.1 The Second party may recognize the First party as a centre for conducting research /training /internship related to the Dissertation/ thesis requirement of the research students for UG/PG & Ph.D. programs on fulfilment of criteria in accordance with the regulations of BBMKU. The Second party may recognize first party for faculties as co-guide of the research scholar(As per the existing Ph.D. regulation of BBMKU) of the of

the Institute as recommended by its DRC of the concerned subjects in accordance with the rules and regulations of the University for guiding students working for the said degree.

1.2 Research instrumentation facility and library facilities available with the First party and the Second party will be made available to the faculties and research scholars and students.

1.3 There shall be an exchange of faculties (scientists)/students for academic, research and training purposes. The duration of exchange visits will be determined by mutual consent between both the parties.

1.4 Both the parties will explore for joint project proposals on areas of mutual interest. The credentials shall be shared equally by both the parties.

Article 2. Management

2.1 Head of the Institution of the First party and the Head of the Institution of the Second party will be responsible for working out operational details of co-operation between the two organizations and ensure proper and efficient implementation of this MoU.

2.2 The MoU Committee will meet at least twice in a year alternatively in the institutions of the First party and the Second party to review the activities. This meeting shall include a presentation of the academic and research activities which should be open to the students, faculties, and research scholars.

Article 3. Exchange of Information

3.1 The term "information" includes scientific or technical data results and/or methods of investigation, and other information intended to be provided exchanged, or arising under project descriptions entered into under this MoU.

3.2 The parties support the widest possible dissemination of information. Each party in joint projects shall be given the right to use, disclose, publish or disseminate such information including innovation and patenting for any and all purposes after taking due consent of other party.

Article 4. General Provisions

4.1 It is understood that the First party and the Second party subscribe to the principle of equal opportunity and do not discriminate by race, sex, age, caste or religion. Both the Institutions shall abide by these principles in the administration of this agreement, and neither party shall impose criteria for exchange of scholars or students which violate principles of non- discrimination.

4.2 Both parties understand that all financial agreements will have to be negotiated separately and will depend on the availability of the funds.

4.3 Any joint research publications arising will be jointly published.

4.4 A copy of the thesis/dissertation in which both the parties are involved will also be handed over to the First party after the award of the degree by the Second party. The attendance of the students will be mutually monitored by the Scientist/faculties/Guides of both the parties while carrying out research activities as per approved research plan.

4.5 All unforeseen issues related to this MoU will be handled by the both parties by mutual agreement as per the provisions of medical/research ethics.

Article 5. Entry into Effect, Modification, and Termination

5.1 This MoU shall become effective on the date it is signed by the parties and shall be valid for five years extendable up to next five years. Both parties shall review the status of the MoU at the end of each five-year period to determine any modifications, whenever necessary. The period of validity of this MoU may be extended by mutual consent up to five years. This MoU may be amended by mutual written agreement and may be terminated at any time by either party upon written notification signed by the competent authority of the party initiating termination. Such notification must be given to the other party at least three months in advance from the effective date of termination.

5.2 All joint activities/ research not completed at the expiration or termination of the MoU may be continued until their completion under the terms of this MoU.

5.3 No amendment or modification of the MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and explicitly stating the same to be an amendment of the MoU. The modifications/changes shall become part of the MoU and shall be effective from the date on which they are made/executed unless otherwise agreed to.

Article 6. Settlement of Disputes

6.1 The parties shall first use reasonable endeavours to amicably settle disputes arising out of or in connection with this collaboration/ agreement.

6.2 Where a dispute has not been amicably resolved the parties shall enter into structured negotiation with the assistance of a mediator acceptable to both sides.

6.3 Where mediation fails, the parties shall settle the dispute through arbitrations, such arbitration shall be conducted under the rules of arbitration of the National/International act by one or more arbitrators appointed in accordance with the said rules, the award of the arbitration shall be final and binding upon the parties subject to the jurisdiction of Dhanbad Court.
